### **Treasurer's Report**

Treasurer's Report 5/20 to 9/18/2014

The Order of the Ring ceremony brought the attendance up to 27 persons. The ceremony had income of \$80 for the rings and expenses of \$80 for the rings and \$55 for shipping and handling fees. The 50/50 resulted in \$11 income. The meals cost \$337.46 with \$520 collected. A returned check and accompanying bank fee cost \$20. Total inflows were \$611, while total outflows were \$492.46, bringing the bank balance to \$4,215.21.

As a reminder, the new season means that \$25 in annual dues are due in September.

2014 SFPE Conference: Reminder the conference is October 12-17, 2014 in Long Beach, CA.

New Business:

Chapter Excellence Award: Eric will complete the paperwork and forward to current and elected officers, as well as Chapter leadership for review.

Career day: Eric Johnson will be presenting at Chucker Creek Elementary 4th grade class.

P.E. Examination Update: Stan provided an update on the current initiative to turn the NCEES examination process to a computer based exam. Over 50,000 examinees sat for the computer based F.E. exam. Each exam was individually different. The FPE P.E. exam is slated to be computer based in 2017. Current FPE P.E.'s need to continue to work on questions to populate the exam base for this transition. The 2014 and 2015 P.E. exams are already established and ready for the examination process. Also, based on review by NCEES, the FPE exam was the best exam with no double answers, not too difficult, and not too easy in its examination. Stan continues to support the examination process and requests through attendance at NCEES meetings.


